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



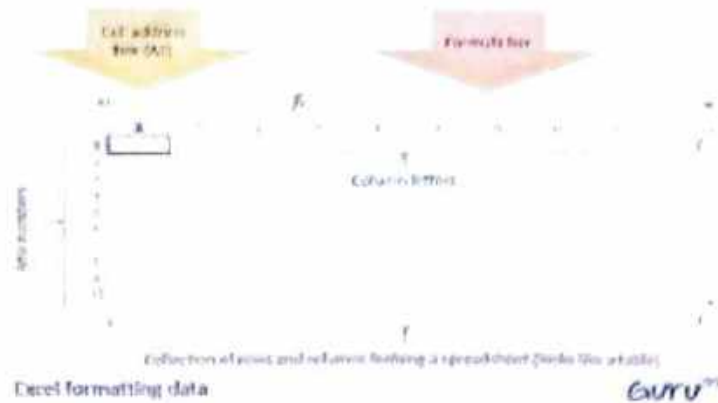

Functions

1. **SUM:** It returns the sum of numeric values in a cell. You can refer to the cells where you have values or simply insert the values into the function.
2. **COUNT:** It returns the count of numeric values in a cell. You can refer to the cells where you have values or simply insert the values into the function.
3. **AVERAGE:** It returns the average of numeric values in a cell. You can refer to the cells where you have values or simply insert the values into the function.
4. **TIME:** It returns a valid time serial number as per Excel's time format. You need to specify hours, minutes and seconds.
5. **DATE:** It returns a valid date serial number as per Excel's time format. You need to specify day, month and year.
6. **LEFT:** This function extracts specific characters from the cell/string starting from the left (start). You need to specify the text and number of characters to extract.
7. **RIGHT:** This function extracts specific characters from the cell/string starting from the right (last). You need to specify the text and number of characters to extract.
8. **VLOOKUP:** It looks up for a value in a column and can return that value or a value from the correspondent columns using same row number.
9. **IF:** This function returns a value when the specific condition is TRUE and returns an other values if condition is FALSE.
10. **NOW:** It returns the current date and time in the cell where you insert it using your system's settings.

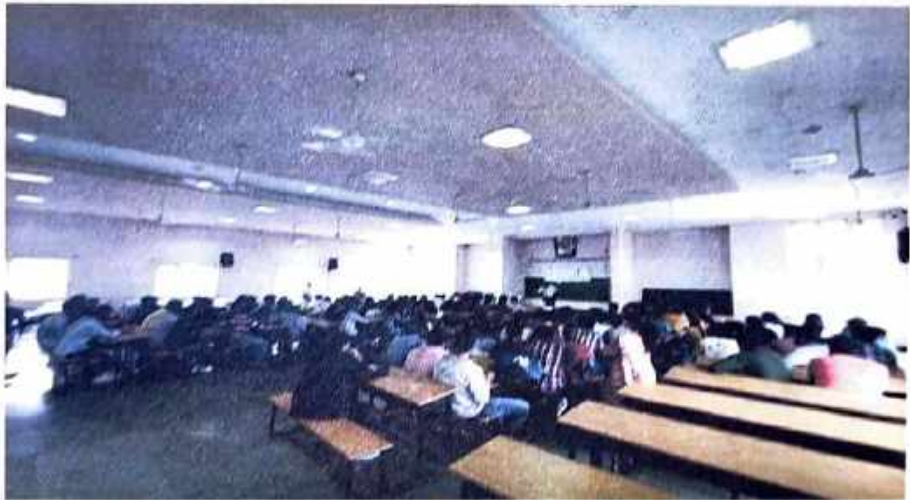

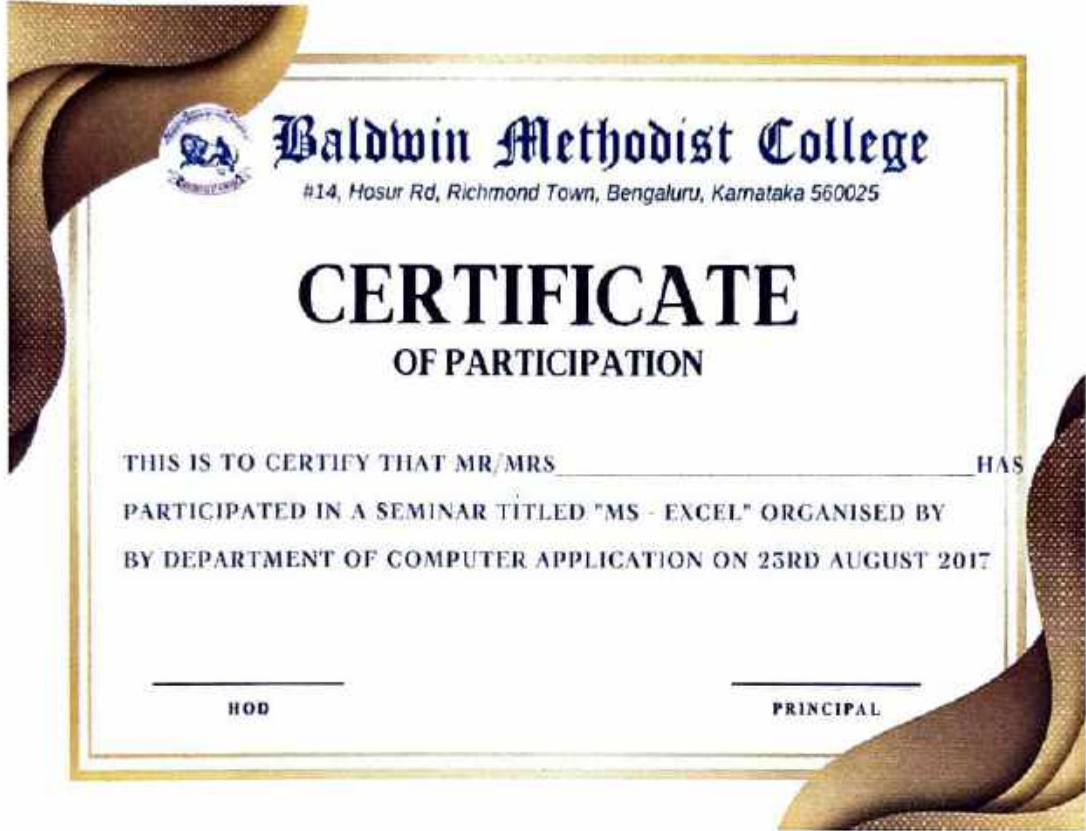

Structure and Example of a Research Report

● Title

This is the title of your systematic investigation. Your title should be concise and point to the aims, objectives, and findings of a research report.

● Table of Contents

This is like a compass that makes it easier for readers to navigate the research report.


● Abstract

An abstract is an overview that highlights all important aspects of the research including the research method, data collection process, and research findings. Think of an abstract as a summary of your research report that presents pertinent information in a concise manner.

● Introduction

In the introduction section, the researcher specifies the research problem and also outlines the significance of the systematic investigation. Also, the researcher is expected to outline any jargons and terminologies that are contained in the research.




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● Literature Review

A literature review is a written survey of existing knowledge in the field of study. In other words, it is the section where you provide an overview and analysis of different research works that are relevant to your systematic investigation.

● An Account of Investigation

This is a detailed account of the research process, including the methodology, sample, and research subjects. Here, you are expected to provide in-depth information on the research process including the data collection and analysis procedures.

● Findings

In this section, you are expected to present the results of the systematic investigation.

● Discussion

This section further explains the findings of the research, earlier outlined. Here, you are expected to present a justification for each outcome and show whether the results are in line with your hypotheses or if other research studies have come up with similar results.

● Conclusions

This is a summary of all the information in the report. It also outlines the significance of the entire study.

● References and Appendices

This section contains a list of all the primary and secondary research sources.

Definition of Tax:

“Tax is an obligatory contribution (Financial charge) from the Person (individual, company, firm, and others) to the government to meet the expenses incurred in the common interest of Society.”

“Tax is imposition financial charge which levied upon a taxpayer by Government authorities for benefit of people in the country”

Basics of Taxation

Taxation plays a prominent role in the economic development of any country. Taxation is a system through which government raises or collect revenue from Public. Governments use these revenues for the welfare of society in various forms like paying salaries of soldiers and police, Construction of dams and roads, to operate schools and hospitals, to provide food to the poor and also medical services, and for other purposes. Without taxes, any government could not exist. Taxation can redistribute a higher class society's wealth by imposing taxes on them in order to maintain equality in society.

Characteristics of Tax:

1. It is a contribution for the benefit of society.
2. It is a personal responsibility.




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3. A tax is paid out of the total income of the taxpayer.
4. A tax requires legal sanction.

Taxation structure (Indian Perspective)

There are mainly two directions of taxes

1. Direct Tax
2. Indirect Tax

Direct Tax: "It is the tax, which is paid directly by the public to the government"

"The tax whose burden directly falls on the taxpayers or it is paid directly by a taxpayer to the respective authority." It cannot be shifted to others. E.g. Income tax.

Indirect Tax: "It is the tax, which is paid indirectly by people to the government."

The burdens of tax indirectly fall on the ultimate consumer are called as Indirect Tax. E.g. Service Tax, These are the taxes that can't be seen by ultimate consumers.

Generally, Direct tax is again divided into the following types:

- a) Income tax- As the name suggests itself it is a tax on the total income of the taxpayer.
- b) Wealth Tax- It is charged on the net wealth of the assessee

Generally, Indirect tax is again divided into the following types:

- a) Central Excise Duty- Excise duty is levied on production or manufacture of goods.
- b) Custom Duty- Custom duty is a duty which is levied by Central Govt. on import of goods and export of goods from India.
- c) Service tax- It is a tax levied on taxable services. Generally, service provider pays tax and recovers from the consumer from the recipient of taxable service




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d) Value Added Tax (VAT) – VAT is a tax on the sale of goods within the states only. It is a multi-stage tax, it is paid by the manufacturer, wholesaler, retailers and finally, it is on transferred on consumer

Basic terms in taxation

Assesse-

In simple words, assessee means a Person by whom any tax or any other sum of money is payable is called assessee. E.g. Mr. Shyam is liable to pay income tax so he is assessee. So any person who is liable to pay tax or any sum of money under the Income Tax Act is called assessee.

Assessment year-

Assessment year means the period of twelve months starting on 1st April every year and ending on 31st March of the next year. E.g. The assessment year 2014-15 will start from 1st April 2014 then period of 12 months and it ends on 31st March 2015

Previous year-

It is the financial year immediately preceding the assessment year. In simple words, the year in which income is earned is known as the previous year. E.g. If any person earns income let's say 2012 this is the previous year and it is taxable in next year i.e. A.Y. 2013

Income-

The definition of income includes profits and gains from business, any winnings from lotteries, crossword puzzles, races and other, income received from dividends, capital gain from transfer of capital assets, any voluntary contributions received by a trust or scientific research association.

Person-

The definition of a person is in an inclusive manner. it includes-




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- An Individual. e.g. Mr. Aakash
- HUF (Hindu Undivided Family).
- Company. E.g. ABC Pvt. Ltd.
- Partnership firm. E.g. M/S A and associates.
- An association of persons (AOP) or a Body of Individuals (BOI).
- Local Authority. E.g. Municipal Corporation.
- Every Artificial Juridical person not falling within any of the above categories. Pune University.

Gross Total Income –

Total of five heads i.e. aggregate of Income from Salaries, Income from House Property, Profits and Gains from Business or Profession, income from Capital Gains, Income from Other Sources.

Total Income-

Gross total income less (minus) permissible deduction under section 80 to 80 U.

Outcome of the event:

1. Students developed awareness about various types of taxes.
2. Students learnt how to be responsible citizens of the country by paying prompt taxes.
3. It helped students to become aware about various tax rates.

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

Patents

A patent is an exclusive right granted by a country to the owner of an invention to make use, manufacture and market the invention, provided the invention satisfies certain conditions stipulated in the law. Exclusive right implies that no one else can make, use, manufacture or market the invention without the consent of the patent holder. This right is available for a limited period of time.

Copyrights

Copyright is a right, which is available for creating an original literary or dramatic or musical or artistic work. Cinematographic films including sound track and video films and recordings on discs, tapes, perforated roll or other devices are covered by copyrights. Computer programs and software are covered under literary works and are protected in India under copyrights.

Industrial Design

Design as per the Indian Act means the features of shape, configuration, pattern, ornament or composition of lines or colors applied to any article -whether in two dimensional or three




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dimensional or in both forms - by any industrial process or means, whether manual, mechanical or chemical, separate or combined, which in the finished article appeal to and are judged solely by the eye.

Trademarks

A trademark is a distinctive sign, which identifies certain goods or services as those produced or provided by a specific person or enterprise. Trademarks may be one or combination of words, letters, and numerals. They may also consist of drawings, symbols, three dimensional signs such as shape and packaging of goods, or colors used as distinguishing feature.

Geographical Indications

Indications which identify a good as originating in the territory of a member or a region or a locality in that territory, where a given quality reputation or other characteristics of the good is attributable to its geographical origin. In goods are manufactured goods one of the activities of either the production.

Circuit Layout Design (IC)

It provides protection for semiconductor IC layout designs. India has now in place Semiconductor Integrated Circuits Layout Design Act, 2000 to give protection to IC layout design. Layout design includes a layout of transistors and other circuitry elements and includes lead wires connecting such elements and expressed in any manner in a semiconductor IC.

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

Step 1 - Decision on doing it yourself or engaging a professional

Step 2 - Check the Patentability of the invention by performing a search for similar technologies

Step 3 - Drafting a patent application (Provisional or Complete)

Step 4 - Filing the patent application in India

Form 1 - Application for grant of a patent

Form 2 — Provisional/Complete specification)

Form 3 - Statement and undertaking regarding foreign application under section 8 (only required if a corresponding patent application is filed in another country)

Form 5 - Declaration as to inventor ship (only to be filed along with the complete application)

Form 26 - Form for authorization of a patent agent (only required if you are using a patent agent to help you file the application)

Form 28 - To be submitted by startup or small entity (only required if you are claiming startup or small entity status)

Step 5 - Publication of patent application

Step 6 - Examination of the patent application

Step 7- Final decision on grant of patent

Step 8- Renewal

CONTENT PRESENTED

The various steps taken by him in setting up the business are as follows:

- (i) **Decision to set up a business:** The first step in establishing own business is of making the final decision to be self-employed.
- (ii) **Environment analysis:** A study of the prevailing business environment is essential to understand the general business climate and the opportunities and threats therein.
- (iii) **Analysing strengths, weaknesses, opportunities and threats (SWOT) analysis:**
This would enable him to find out the type and size of business most suitable to him.
- (iv) **Training:** Various institutes like EDI, NIESBUD, IEDs offer tailor-made and module-based EDPs for new and existing entrepreneurs as well as for employees of small scale businesses.
- (v) **Product development and selection:** An important decision as to the product choice is taken at this stage.
- (vi) **Market survey:** Marketability is the true test of goodness of a product.
- (vii) **Form of organisation:** Selection of the most suitable form of organisation is a precondition for long-term business success.
- (viii) **Location:** It means the specific place or site of business.
- (ix) **Technology:** Here, information on all available technologies is procured by the entrepreneur and the most suitable production technology is identified.
- (x) **Machinery and equipment:** Having chosen the type of plant and machinery, manufacturers and suppliers are shortlisted and purchase orders are placed depending upon machine quality.




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- (xi) **Preparation of project report:** This report compiles information regarding progress of the project through every stage.
- (xii) **Project appraisal:** Ordinarily, project appraisal implies a cost and benefit analysis of business.
- (xiii) **Arranging finance:** Arrangements are made for procuring adequate and timely finance to meet both fixed and working capital requirements. .
- (xiv) **Provisional registration of business:** The DIC or the Directorate of Industries provide the prescribed application form for provisional registration.
- (xv) **Procuring technical know-how:** In technology-driven businesses, the technical know-how can be arranged through TCOs, NSIC, SSIDC, DIC, SISI, EDIs, private consultants or foreign collaborations.
- (xvi) **Electricity and water connection:** Applications to the relevant power and water supply authorities are made for procuring connections.
- (xvii) **Installation of machinery:** The plant layout scheme would guide the machine installation.
- (xviii) **Manpower recruitment:** Human resource is considered to be the most important input for a business.
- (xix) **Purchase of raw material:** The raw materials are purchased indigenously or through imports. Some major issues concerning raw material procurement are quality, price and assured supply.
- (xx) **Starting production:** With all the factors of production, namely, manpower, raw material, machines and equipment in place, a trial run is given to the production work. This is followed by mass scale commercial production.
- (xxi) **Marketing:** Each single business activity is directed towards ensuring effective marketing results.
- (xxii) **Quality assurance:** Depending upon the type of product, the entrepreneur applies for quality certification from the Bureau of Indian Standards (BIS) or Agricultural Produce Grading and Marking (AGMARK), etc.
- (xxiii) **Permanent registration:** After a small scale enterprise starts production and marketing, it becomes eligible to obtain permanent registration on the basis of earlier provisional registration




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(xxiv) **Market research:** A rewarding business practice that keeps the business alive, fresh and competitive is its constant pursuit to obtain knowledge of market-related variables like competition, future demand forecasts, customer preferences, and supply-related developments etc.

(xxv) **Profit generation and reinvestment of profits:** Once the venture starts making profits, an important task is to set aside a substantial portion of earnings for investing back in business. It is essential to ensure survival and growth of the business.
